Deputy Waheed made contact with the suspect, who had signs of intoxication. While detaining the suspect for his public intoxicated display, the suspect would attempt to resist. His resistance was futile and earned him an additional charge. The suspect was charged with public intoxication and obstruction of justice. He was held at Rappahannock Regional Jail until sober.
