DUI

Traveling on Garrisonville Road can be stressful, especially when one driver traveling Eastbound had trouble maintaining the lane of travel. Deputies conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle and made contact with the driver. The driver had signs of intoxication and admitted to consuming "three Coronas" prior to driving. He was charged with driving under the influence and held at Rappahannock Regional Jail until sober.
