## **ASSAULT**

Walgreens, 50 White Oak Road, 9/10, 10:01 p.m. Deputies responded to an unknown problem. It was advised a juvenile was walking along the train tracks. As deputies attempted to check the welfare of the juvenile, he would kick a deputy in the groin. The deputy was not seriously injured and the juvenile was detained. A criminal complaint for assault and battery on law enforcement was submitted. The juvenile was detained at the Juvenile Detention Center.

Rappahannock Regional Jail, 1745 Richmond Highway, 9/10, 10:42 p.m. Deputy R.T. Philippsen responded to an assault. It was advised an inmate was refusing jail staff's commands. The situation escalated when the inmate charged at a staff member and assaulted them. The staff member was not seriously injured and the inmate was detained. Warrants for assault and battery on jail staff, as well as, obstruction of justice were obtained.

## **DRUGS**

Staff wandered into the bathroom to discover a student vaping. Staff conducted a search and discovered she was in possession of a THC vape. The reporting party advised they observed the driver of an Audi smoking something while driving around. Deputy Trainor made contact with the driver who had signs of intoxication. She was charged with driving under the influence, refusal, and possession was a fictitious license. She was held at Rappahannock Regional Jail without bond.
