ASSAULT

America's Best Inn, 605 Warrenton Road, 9/11, 8:06 p.m. Deputy S.A. Edwards responded to an assault. It was advised a guest was acting belligerently towards his girlfriend. When asked to leave the establishment by staff, he assaulted both his girlfriend and a staff member. Later, Deputy N.J. Amato and Deputy J.W. Ahern would locate the suspect and detain him. He was charged with assault and battery and was released by the magistrate on personal recognizance.

DRUGS

Stafford High School, 63 Stafford Indians Lane, 9/11, 12:20 p.m. Deputy V.L. Powell was conducting her SRO duties when she was informed of drug activity. Staff discovered a student in possession of a THC vape. A criminal complaint for underage possession was submitted.

LARCENY

Walmart, 125 Washington Square Plaza, 9/11, 2:50 p.m. Deputy T.S. Myree responded to a larceny. The victim advised she had a brief conversation with a female suspect in the parking lot. Afterwards, she noticed her debit card was missing. The victim would later receive notification of fraudulent transactions.

THREATS

Stefaniga Road, 9/11, 11:53 a.m. Deputy D.J. Ferrell responded to a threats call. The victim received a call from the suspect advising he was going to shoot the victim. Deputy Ferrell made contact with the suspect by phone, who reiterated the threat. Deputy Ferrell confirmed that everyone at the residence was safe and submitted a warrant for threats by phone on the suspect. He has not yet been served.
