DISTURBANCE

Brooke Point High School, 1700 Courthouse Road, 9/4, 1:50 p.m. Deputy D.J. Taylor was conducting his SRO duties when he was informed of a disturbance. A guardian disobeyed security officers directing traffic and nearly struck them. Deputy Taylor made contact with the suspect, who was back at the school. He began making a rather large scene and made threats towards school staff. Charges for disorderly conduct and making threats to school staff are pending.
